The Village Hall stands next door to St John's Church.

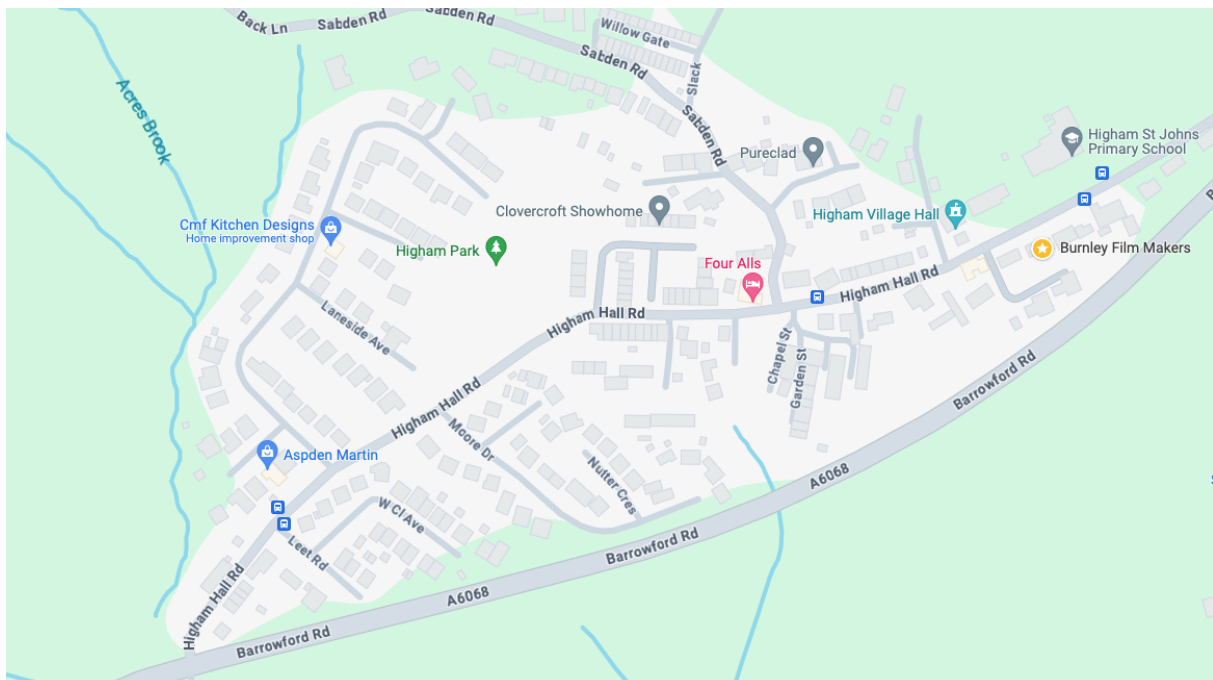
Parking – if you drive past the hall and the church you will see St Johns Primary school and free parking will be available here all day.

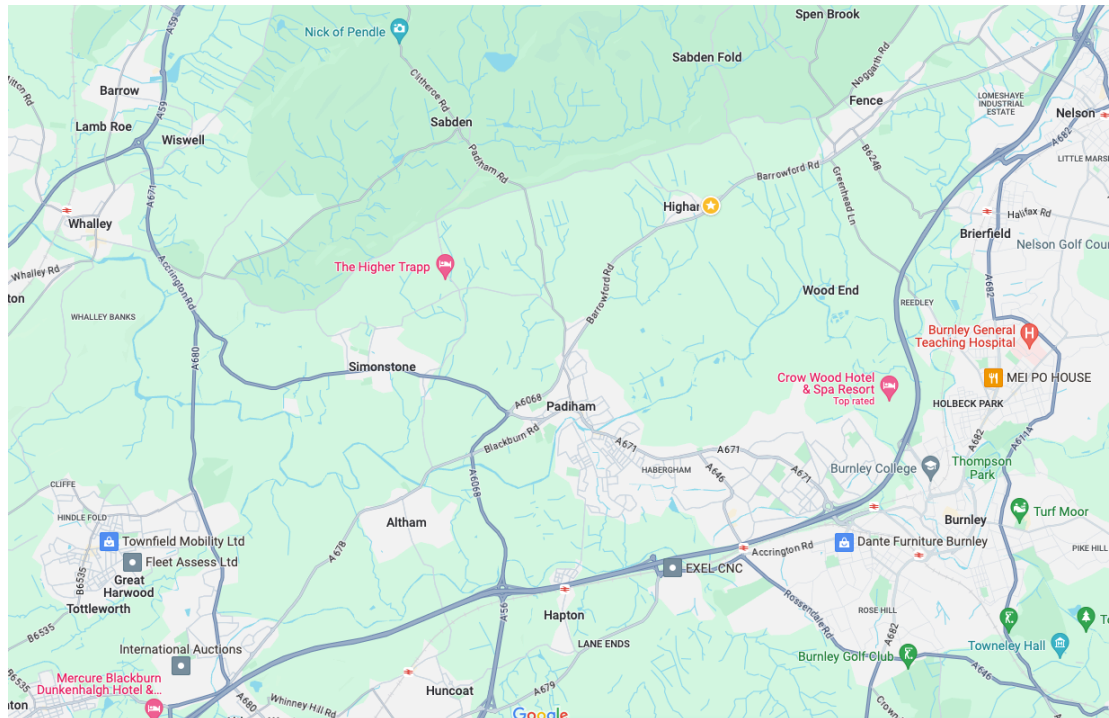
Getting here

Access to the village of Higham is via the A6068 Barrowford Road (We locals call it the Padiham by-pass) which connects Barrowford to Padiham. The village Hall, church and school are located toward one end of the village as shown below.



If you are travelling from the North, South, East or West you will probably arrive via the M65 motorway which starts at Preston and ends at Colne.

The Google Map below shows the M65 section from Accrington to Nelson.



Coming from Preston / Blackburn end of the **M65**, take **Junction 8** towards Padiham. Follow the A6068. There are two sets of traffic lights – carry on along the A6068 Barrowford Road. You will see signs for Higham and drive through the village until you see the Village Hall, Church and the school for parking.

If you are arriving from the Colne end of the M65, you need to come off at **Junction 13** at Nelson and take the Barrowford Road / Padiham road as shown below.
